Notes: Sustainable Building Materials and Nanotechnology do not have industry sector codes. The code for the "Medical & Diagnostic Laboratories" subsector is 6215, not 621 as provided by Enterprise Florida. Code 621 is "Ambulatory health care services," which is basically doctors, dentists, outpatient services, and home health care. For Space Research & Technology (NAICS 927), there are only 9 reporting entities in the state (~2,100 jobs; ~\$100,000 average wages), owned by either federal or local government interests.
